SEASON 7 - EPISODE 9 - "UNTETHERED"

SEEKING:

[DONNY CARLSON] 19 years old. Caucasian. Manic-depressive. Given

an unjustly harsh sentence of one year in an upstate NY prison for being a passenger in a car containing illegal drugs. When he alerts someone with connections to GOREN about ongoing prisoner abuse, GOREN becomes interested in his case. (GUEST LEAD)

[DR. STERN] 40s. Female. Weary staff psychiatrist at an upstate NY prison. Tries to treat and help the troubled prisoners as much as she can in a very hostile atmosphere. Any ethnicity. (SUPPORTING)

[SHEP] Late 30s. Prisoner at upstate NY prison who has a good relationship with the guards due to his apparent good behavior. Serves food to his fellow inmates in the cafeteria. While he appears to protect newer, weaker inmates, his kind manner hides a darker agenda. (3 scenes)

[WARDEN PELLIS] 50s. Female. Tough, no-nonsense prison warden at an upstate NY prison. Rules with an iron fist. Comes into conflict with GOREN when he investigates allegations of prison abuse occurring under her watch (2 scenes)

[GARVIN] 30s. Male prison guard at an upstate NY prison with a reputation for treating prisoners harshly. Rubs GOREN the wrong way when he is upstate investigating a case. Any ethnicity (4 scenes)

[MANOS] 40s. Male prison guard in an upstate NY prison with a reputation for treating prisoners harshly. Rubs GOREN the wrong way when he is upstate investigating a case. Any ethnicity (4 scenes)

[ELLEN LOWRY] 40s. Lives in a lower middle class home in a small upstate NY town. Loving mother of imprisoned Jay Lowry. Heartbroken about how her son's life has turned out. Questioned by GOREN and EAMES with her husband James about Jay's treatment in prison. (1 scene)

[JAMES LOWRY] Mid-40s. Jock type. Lives in a lower middle class home in a small upstate NY town. More ashamed of his son's effeminate nature and homosexuality than his imprisonment. Questioned by GOREN and EAMES with his wife Ellen about Jay's treatment in prison. (1 scene)

[JAY LOWRY] Early 20s male. Feminine features. Schizophrenic. Prisoner at an upstate NY prison. His mistreatment by the prison guards leads to tragedy. (3 scenes in teaser)

[EAGLE] 30s. Imposing. Homeless man who threatens people into giving him money and food. Any ethnicity. (3 scenes in teaser)

[LANG] 20s. Local upstate NY rookie cop. Amused by the situation

when he and his partner Ulrich have to book an unusual perp. (1 scene)

[ULRICH] 40s. Veteran upstate NY cop. A bit over it when he and his rookie partner Lang have to book an unusual perp. (1 scene)

[NANCY] 30s. Nurse at an upstate NY prison. Tries her best to care for the prisoners under difficult circumstances. Any ethnicity. (1 scene and 1 non-speaking scene)

[CLYDE OVERTON] Late 40s-early 50s. Slick. Car salesman in a small town in upstate NY whose part-time job is town judge. Responsible for Donny Carlson's overly harsh sentence. Has a run in with GOREN. (1 scene)

[WELLS] 40s. Prison guard at upstate NY prison with a reputation for treating prisoners harshly. Any ethnicity. (2 lines in 2 scenes)

[AL] 19 years old. Caucasian. Thin and frail. Prisoner at an upstate NY prison. Seen being given his meds. He is later abused by a fellow inmate. (2 non-speaking scenes)
